Dear Training Program Participant,

AgConnect (<a href="https://agconnectpa.org/">https://agconnectpa.org/</a>) can help offset the cost of SFI logger training courses for eligible employers/trainees with a reimbursement of up to 50% of the course cost. Funding is provided through grants by the Pennsylvania Department of Labor and Industry, the PA Department of Community and Economic Development, and the Chester County Workforce Development Board.



Trainees must be employed residents of Pennsylvania, and the training course must be related to agriculture or agribusiness. Forestry and timber harvesting related trainings are included.

- PA SFI Training Courses
- Game of Logging Training Courses
- CPR, First Aid, AED Training

As a condition of the grant funding, recipients are required to report training outcomes, such as employee retention, a projected wage increase, or acquisition of an industry recognized credential such as SFI Qualified Logging Professional.

As required by the Department of Labor and Industry, trainees must provide their social security number and date of birth. Personal data is not retained and is used for state reporting ONLY. The application also requires that the company enters their NAICS Industry Code. For logging this is: 113310

This necessitates sustaining the economic value of current and future timber products, the environmental benefits provided by the forests, and the social values that Pennsylvanians derive from using and interacting with our forests. This training will help my company to better steward these values and resources and comply with the state and federal regulations that govern timber harvesting in Pennsylvania. This training will also help my company comply with the requirements of the Pennsylvania SFI Professional Timber Harvester Training Program.

<u>Personal Safety</u> — With timber harvesting being one of the most dangerous occupations in Pennsylvania, this training will help my company be safer in carrying out harvesting operations. Safety training will first and foremost guard personnel against life-changing injuries or fatalities and prepare our company for emergency response, and secondarily reduce company downtime resulting from staff being off from work due to injuries. It will also help my company comply with pertinent aspects of OSHA regulations and with the requirements of the Pennsylvania SFI Professional Timber Harvester Training Program.
